

# Stump Grinder Teeth How to Determine What You Need

### **Check your Pockets**


Pockets have a number on them that correlates to the series tooth that it fits.

| Series Teeth      | Number on Pocket |
|-------------------|------------------|
| Series 500 teeth  | 5                |
| Series 700 teeth  | 7                |
| Series 900 teeth  | 9                |
| Series 1100 teeth | 11               |

#### **Check your Tooth Height**

Each new series stump tooth is a specific height. Wear and tear from use may affect this measurement.

| Series Teeth      | Tooth Height |
|-------------------|--------------|
| Series 500 teeth  | 1.836 inches |
| Series 700 teeth  | 2.048 inches |
| Series 900 teeth  | 2.318 inches |
| Series 1100 teeth | 2.661 inches |



#### **Check your Horsepower**

The horsepower of your machine typically corresponds to the series teeth that you are running.

| Horsepower    |  |
|---------------|--|
| Up to 20      |  |
| From 20 to 45 |  |
| From 45 to 85 |  |
| 85 or more    |  |
|               | Up to 20<br>From 20 to 45<br>From 45 to 85 |







## **Check your Wrench**

You will need a different size wrench to remove the nut for each series stump tooth.

| Series Teeth      | Wrench Size |
|-------------------|-------------|
| Series 500 teeth  | 1/2-inch    |
| Series 700 teeth  | 9/16-inch   |
| Series 900 teeth  | 5/8-inch    |
| Series 1100 teeth | 3/4-inch    |
